## Nuclear Physics Long Range Plan 2024

**Bucharest, April 15<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup>, 2024**

The upcoming NuPECC Long Range Plan 2024 Town Meeting will take place in Bucharest, Romania, from April 15<sup>th</sup> (noon) to 17<sup>th</sup> (noon), 2024. The venue will be the Marriott Hotel in the centre of Bucharest, (<https://www.marriott.com/en-us/hotels/buhro-jw-marriott-bucharest-grand-hotel/overview/>) located in Calea 13 Septembrie 90, Sector 5, 050726 Bucharest, Romania.

The aim of this meeting is to bring together the Nuclear Physics community in Europe to discuss the long range perspectives in our field and decide how best to develop it in the next ten to fifteen years. A draft of the LRP2024 Report and its Recommendations will be presented and discussed during the meeting.
